### **Example from Germany**

- DIN German Institute for standardization
- S Authorized by the federal government, contract from 1975
- S is the national platform for standardization
- Standardization principles outlined in standard DIN 820-1 are mandatory by the contract
- According to DIN 820-1 standardization must not lead to a special benefit for certain stakeholders
- DIN has to ensure balanced composition of the technical committees.

DIN undertakes various tasks to fulfil these obligations

- Source For SME Commission for SME
- SME Helpdesk
- Semote participation for DIN meetings
- Since commenting tool for national and european standards
- Standardization portals for certain domains (architecture, ventilation systems, etc.)
